Course Overview

This course demonstrates the importance of a better-organised working environment - the principles and benefits of the 5S approach, how to start its implementation - and profit from it.

5S is a technique adapted from the Japanese. The basic idea is very simple - keeping everything clean and orderly will increase efficiency and boost morale, with a significant improvement in the safety of your work environment and a consistently higher quality of product or service - which in turn impacts on the bottom line.

The principle behind 5S is one of continuous improvement, looking at how each task is carried out and continually seeking to improve efficiency and quality. It's pictured as a cycle: planning what to do, carrying it out, reviewing how it went and making adjustments before embarking on the next cycle.
